## INTRODUCTION

**CHILDREN-Nepal (CN)** was founded 1995 by a group of Nepali professionals who had a difficult childhood.

They were concerned about the number of children living on the margins of society, out of reach from existing social institutions and affected by abuse and crime.

### Some of the main factors for this situation are:

- The inability of their family to provide basic needs such as food, clothes, education and health care
- The inability of parents to provide emotional support because they also had a difficult childhood
- The lack of access to social services

- **Education** for children and youth in need
- **Self-Help Groups** give children and youth the chance to learn from each other and become responsible for their rights
